c The Michael and Marian Ilitch School of Business building (Project #3 above) was initially included on the JCOS report for the period ending December 31, 2015 with a total project cost of \$50,000,000. Subsequent to that date, the project budget was increased by \$9,000,000 to a total revised budget of \$59,000,000. The most significant factor contributing to the increase is the current construction market in Detroit which has created fierce competition and resulting inflation for skilled trades.

The projected funding sources for this project were modified from the previous report to reflect \$15,000,000 in bond proceeds and \$44,000,000 in donations.
